
ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS





Launceton Large Square Lantern in Antique

Item # CHC 5612

WE RECOMMEND INSTALLATION OF THIS LIGHTING FIXTURE BE DONE BY A LICENSED ELECTRICIAN.

WARNING***SWITCH OFF THE MAIN ELECTRICAL SUPPLY FROM THE MAIN FUSE BOX/CIRCUIT BREAKER BEFORE INSTALLATION.

INSPECT ITEM CAREFULLY BEFORE ATTEMPTING TO INSTALL. IF THERE IS ANY DAMAGE OR OBVIOUS DEFECT. DO NOT INSTALL.

ITEM MAY NOT BE RETURNED ONCE IT HAS BEEN INSTALLED.

- 1. Carefully remove all parts from the box.
- 2. Hang up the center stem (H) to the lamp body (I)
- 3. Install the glass (J) to the lantern frame, and secure by the tabs.
- 4. Unscrew the quick link (F) on one end of chain (G) and hang it onto the lamp body (I), close the quick link to secure the lamp body (I).
- 5. Unwrap the wiring from the lamp body (H), twist power supply and ground wire together.

 And pass through center hole of lock collar (E), canopy (D).
- Connect the safety steel wire from the fixture and the safety cable from ceiling with cable lock nut.
- 7. Connect the hot wire (BLACK) from the fixture to the hot wire from the outlet box (usually BLACK). Fasten them together with a plastic wire connectors (A) provided and wrap the connection with electrical tape.
- Connect the neutral wire (WHITE) from the fixture to the wire from the outlet box (usually WHITE).
 - DO NOT REVERSE THE HOT AND NEUTRAL CONNECTIONS OR SAFETY WILL BE COMPROMISED.
- Connect ground wire from the fixture (bare copper) to ground wire from the outlet box (usually green or copper in color).
 - IT IS IMPERATIVE THAT THIS FIXTURE BE GROUNDED.
- 10. Unscrew the quick link (F) on another end of chain (G) and hang it to the ceiling loop(C), close the quick link (F).
- 11. Attach the canopy (D) to the ceiling loop (C) by securing with lock collar (E).
- 12. Insert bulbs (not included) into the sockets.
- 13. Installation is complete, turn on power at fuse or circuit breaker.

***Clean with a dry, soft cloth only. Use no harsh abrasives or chemical agents.
