

## Caron Large Chandelier Item # TOB 5046

WE RECOMMEN D INSTALLATION OF THIS LIGHTING FIXTUREBEDONEBY A LICENSED ELECTRICIAN. WARNING\*\*\*SWITCH OFF THE MAIN ELECTRICAL SUPPLY FROM THE MAIN FUSE BOX/CIRCUIT BREAKER BEFORE INSTALLATION. INSPECT ITEM CAREFULLY BEFORE ATTEMPTING TO INSTALL. IF THERE IS ANY DAMAGE OR OBVIOUS DEFECT. DO NOT INSTALL. ITEM MAY NOT BE RETURNED ONCE IT HAS BEEN INSTALLED.

- 1. Carefully remove all parts from the box.
- 2. Remove the mounting plate (B) from canopy (F) by loosening the side screws (D).
- 3. Install the mounting plate (B) to the outlet box with mounting screws (C) provided.
- 4. Thread the center tube (H) to the fixture body.
- 5. Thread the tube (E) to tube (H).
- 6. Let canopy (F) go through the tube (E).
- 7. Hang up the assembled fixture body to the mounting plate (B).
- Connect the fixture ground (bare) wire with the ground wire from the outlet box using wire nut (A). If your house does not have ground wire, then attach this wire to the green grounding screw inside of the outlet box.

IT IS IMPERATIVE THAT THIS FIXTURE BE GROUNDED.

- Connect the fixture Neutral wire (ribbed, no markings) with the neutral wire from the outlet box using wire nut (A).
- 10. Connect the fixture Hot (smooth edge,markings) wire with the hot wire from the outlet box using wire nut (A).

DO NOT REVERSE THE HOT AND NEUTRAL CONNECTIONS OR SAFETY WILL BE COMPROMISED.

- 11. Tuck these wire connections neatly into the outlet box to secure.
- 12. Put canopy (F) to the mounting plate (B), and secure with side screws (D).
- 13. Assemble shades (J) on the sockets (I) .
- 14. Insert bulbs (not included) into the sockets.
- 15. Installation is complete, turn on power at fuse or circuit breaker.
